Please note that this list is a suggestion only and should be adjusted to meet your own needs.

axe & woodsaw		Useful to cut logs.	<input type="checkbox"/>
brew kit		Pack of tea and sachets of milk and sugar can help restore morale!	<input type="checkbox"/>
bug jacket & bug spray		To keep bugs away.	<input type="checkbox"/>
candles		Can help start a fire.	<input type="checkbox"/>
dry boots		To replace wet boots and keep you warm conditions.	<input type="checkbox"/>
dry clothing (Extra)		To replace wet cloths or to add layers. Will help keep you warm.	<input type="checkbox"/>
compass, maps & GPS		Compass will help you to find your way. GPS can be useful too, but you must make sure you have batteries that work. A map of the area where you plan to go can help you find your way if you are lost.	<input type="checkbox"/>

cooking pots & pans		Useful for boiling water and cooking food.	<input type="checkbox"/>
dry food (extra Meats??)		Perfect for travelling (light and compact).	<input type="checkbox"/>
supply of gas		Extra gas can be useful if you are travelling longer or further than expected	<input type="checkbox"/>
fishing gear (fishing nets, line & hooks)		Fishing gear can help you if food packed is not sufficient.	<input type="checkbox"/>

first-aid kit		Necessary in cases of injuries.	<input type="checkbox"/>
flare gun		Useful to signal your presence.	<input type="checkbox"/>
flashlight with extra batteries		Useful if you need to work in dark conditions.	<input type="checkbox"/>
food, extra foods(??)		Extra food is useful if you are travelling for a longer period than expected.	<input type="checkbox"/>
harpoon & avataq		Useful for hunting.	<input type="checkbox"/>
HF radio, SAT-phone		The HF Radio and SAT-Phone serve to communicate in cases of emergency.	<input type="checkbox"/>

matches, lighter & magnifying glass		Matches are the best tool to make a fire. You can waterproof your matches by dripping them with candle wax. A magnifying glass can help you start a fire if you don't have any matches. You need to use the energy from the sun with lichen or small branches to start the fire.	<input type="checkbox"/>
mattress & sleeping bag		A good insulation from the cold soil .	<input type="checkbox"/>
paddles		If you have mechanical problems...	<input type="checkbox"/>
PFD Life Vest (life jacket?)		The PDF Life Vest is very important when you use boat or canoe.	<input type="checkbox"/>
stove & fuel		To heat food and beverages.	<input type="checkbox"/>
rain gear		Very useful during rainy days.	<input type="checkbox"/>
sewing kit (with needles and strong thread)		To repair your equipment.	<input type="checkbox"/>

sun block & sun glasses and hat or cap		To prevent sunstroke during long sunny days.	<input type="checkbox"/>
tarp & rope		Tarp can be used to build a shelter in cases of emergency. Ropes can be useful to tie your tarp and for several other uses.	<input type="checkbox"/>

tool-box, with motoparts		To repair mechanical problems.	<input type="checkbox"/>
